

O R D I N A N C E NO. 105

AN ORDINANCE AMDENDING SECTION 4.10.130 OF THE ENNIS TOWN CODE TO READ AS FOLLOWS:

4.10.130 Fees and Charges. The Council shall by Resolution set a connection and inspection charge for each and every new installation of water service within the Town. The owner of the property to which new service is furnished shall in addition pay the Town for the meter installed as required by the Town. The contractor performing such service shall be licensed within the Town and shall complete the construction to the satisfaction of the Water Commissioner and any other inspector as required by law.

When the water main does not extend to a point contiguous to property to be served by reason of voluntary annexation, the property owner seeking annexation and service shall pay for the extension of the water main.

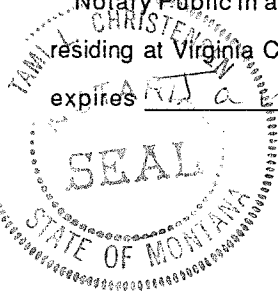
