

ORDINANCE NO. 10

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR ONE POLLING OR VOTING PLACE ONLY
IN THE TOWN OF ENNIS.

BE IT ORDAINED by the town council of the Town of Ennis:

1. That for all general elections for town officers, or for all special elections for bond issues, increasing tax levies, or for any other kind of election there shall be one polling or voting place only.
2. Such polling or voting place shall be determined by the town council.
3. Due to the town election to be held on April 6, 1959 this measure is deemed an emergency, and shall be in full force immediately upon the passage and approval of same.
