

ORDINANCE NO. 110

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 9.10.010 OF THE ENNIS TOWN CODE TO READ AS FOLLOWS:

9.10.010 Regulations. It shall be a violation of this chapter to ignite, explode, or fire off any fireworks within the town limits on any day of the year; however, upon application to the Town Commission, duly approved by the Commission and the Mayor, bona fide persons and organizations may obtain a permit for the use of fireworks in connection with celebrations or other occasions of public interest. Fireworks include, but are not limited to, firecrackers, roman candles, rockets, or other fireworks or substances intended for pyrotechnic display or demonstration.
