4.10.080 Turning Off Water by Request.

After the payment of fifteen dollars (\$15.00) from property owner or designated agent, water may be turned off on property that will be vacant and there will be a minimum charge assessed while the property is vacant. If the water is not turned off at the main, when the property is vacant, property owner or designated agent will be charged the minimum rate. A charge of fifteen dollars (\$15.00) will be assessed to restore the service.
