

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF ENNIS,
SETTING FINES FOR ANYONE OF ILLEGAL AGE FISHING IN THE
TOWN OF ENNIS LION'S PARK POND.

The purpose of this ordinance is to establish fines for
anyone caught illegally fishing in the Lion's Park Pond
and to identify who is authorized to issue citations for
this law.

WHEREAS, it has been established that only persons of the age
of twelve (12) and under may fish in the pond located in the Lion's
Park of the Town of Ennis; and

WHEREAS, the Council for the Town of Ennis has been requested
to establish a law stating that only persons twelve (12) and under
may fish in the Lion's Park Pond and fines set for the breaking of
this law; and

WHEREAS, the Council has determined that this is within their
jurisdiction of setting laws.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN
OF ENNIS, MONTANA THAT:

No persons over the age of twelve (12) will be allowed to fish in the
Lion's Park Pond of the Town of Ennis.

Anyone found to be fishing in the Lion's Pond who is over the age of
twelve (12) years will be issued a citation by any law enforcement
agency of the State of Montana and brought before the City Court of
the Town of Ennis.

Fines for any citations issued for the illegal fishing in the Lion's
Park Pond will be \$25.00 for the first offense, maximum of \$75.00
and \$100.00 for each subsequent offense; plus a \$15.00 surcharge.
This ordinance becomes effective thirty (30) days after its final
passage.

ORDINANCE NO. 119
AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF ENNIS, SETTING FINES FOR ANYONE OF ILLEGAL AGE FISHING IN THE TOWN OF ENNIS LIONS PARK POND.

The purpose of this ordinance is to establish fines for anyone caught illegally fishing in the Lions Park Pond and to identify who is authorized to issue citations for this law.

WHEREAS, it has been established that only persons of the age of twelve (12) and under may fish in the pond located in the Lions Park of the Town of Ennis; and

WHEREAS, the Council for the Town of Ennis has been requested to establish a law stating that only persons twelve (12) and under may fish in the Lions Park Pond and fines set for the breaking of this law; and

WHEREAS, the Council has determined that this is within their jurisdiction of setting laws.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF ENNIS, MONTANA, THAT:

No persons over the age of twelve (12) will be allowed to fish in the Lions Park Pond of the Town of Ennis.

Anyone found to be fishing in the Lions Pond who is over the age of twelve (12) years will be issued a citation by any law enforcement agency of the State of Montana and brought before the City Court of the Town of Ennis.

Fines for any citation issued for the illegal fishing in the Lions Park Pond will be \$25.00 for the first offense, maximum of \$75.00 and \$100.00 for each subsequent offense; plus a \$15.00 surcharge.

This ordinance becomes effective thirty (30) days after its final passage.
