

ORDINANCE NO. 12

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 4 OF ORDINANCE NO. 1 PROVIDING FOR THE LICENSING OF BUSINESSES TO BE PAID ON A YEARLY BASIS RATHER THAN ON A QUARTERLY BASIS; AND PROVIDING FOR THE INCREASE OF LICENSE FEES ON CERTAIN BUSINESSES; AND PROVIDING FOR THE REPEALING OF ALL PARTS OF ORDINANCE NO. 1 IN CONFLICT WITH ORDINANCE NO. 12.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF ENNIS:

That Section 4 of Ordinance No.1 be amended to read as follows:

The License to be issued shall be issued by the Town Clerk and shall be countersigned by the Mayor and the Town Clerk shall collect therefor the sum of \$12.00 per year from all operators having established businesses in Ennis or those operators who come into the Town of Ennis and transact business periodically or regularly during the year. Provided, however, the Town Clerk shall collect from retail liquor establishments the sum of \$62.00 for an annual license. All annual licenses to be due and payable on the first day of July of each year.

Peddlers and others who transact business in the Town of Ennis occasionally or seasonally may obtain a license for \$3.00 per quarter or fraction thereof. This quarterly license will not permit selling from vehicles parked on any street or alley in the Town of Ennis.

THAT SECTION ~~4~~ 5 OF ORDINANCE NO.1 be repealed entirely.

THESE AMENDMENTS TO BE EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 1959.
