

ORDINANCE NO. 19

AN ORDINANCE PRESCRIBING THE DUTIES OF THE TOWN MARSHAL UPON MAKING AN ARREST FOR A HIGHWAY OR DRIVING VIOLATION; GRANTING THE SAID TOWN MARSHALL THE POWER TO SET AND ACCEPT BOND AND GIVE RECEIPT THEREFOR AND PRESCRIBING DISPOSITION OF THE BOND.

Be it ordained by the Town Council of The Town of Ennis:

That the Town Marshall upon making an arrest for highway and driving violation, shall either deliver the offender to the Town Police Judge during office hours or to the county jail or in lieu thereof, deliver the offender a form of summons describing the nature of the offense with instructions thereon for the offender to report to the Town Police Judge, or in lieu of reporting to the Town Police Judge and during such hours as the said Town Police Judge is not available and in the case of non-resident of the Town, the said Town Marshall has the right to set and accept a deposit for appearance justifiable for the offense charged. In the event the Town Marshall sets and accepts bail, he shall give a signed receipt to the offender setting forth the amount received. The Marshall shall then deliver the bail money to the Town Police Judge and the Town Police Judge shall give a receipt to the Marshall therefor. After filing of the complaint and appearance of the defendant, the Town Police Judge shall assume jurisdiction and may, set fix and accept further appearance bond as he shall see fit.
