

ORDINANCE NO. 2

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE USE OF FIREWORKS WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE TOWN OF ENNIS EXCEPT ON THE THIRD AND FOURTH AND FIFTH OF JULY, PROVIDING FOR PERMITS FOR USE OF FIREWORKS ON CERTAIN PUBLIC OCCASSIONS AND PROVIDING FOR FINE IN CASE OF VIOLATION THEREOF.

Be it Ordained by the Town Council of the Town of Ennis:

Section 1. It shall be a violation of this ordinance to ignite, explode or fire off any rockets, firecrackers, Roman candles, torpedoes or any other substance of an explosive nature within the corporate limits of the Town of Ennis on any day of the year other than the Third, Fourth and Fifth days of July in each and every year provided, however, that upon application to the Town Council, duly approved by the council and the Mayor bona fide persons and organizations may obtain a permit for the use of fireworks in connection with celebrations or other occasions of public interest.

Section 2. Violations of this ordinance shall be punishable by a fine of not less than \$ 5.00 nor more than \$ 50.00.
