

ORDINANCE NO. 32

AN ORDINANCE FORBIDDING THE TURNING ON OF CITY WATER IN THE TOWN OF ENNIS BY ANY PERSON EXCEPT THE WATER COMMISSIONER OR SOME ONE DESIGNATED BY HIM; AND THE OPENING AND THE USING OF WATER FROM ANY FIRE HYDRANT IN THE TOWN OF ENNIS EXCEPT BY THE FIRE CHIEF OR A FIREMAN IN CASE OF FIRE OR FOR THE USE OF WATER FOR SOME MUNICIPAL PURPOSE AUTHORIZED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF ENNIS; AND PROVIDING PUNISHMENT FOR SUCH VIOLATIONS.

BE IT ORDANINED by the Town Council of the Town of Ennis.

1. Any person, firm or coporation residing either inside or outside of the corporate limits of the Town of Ennis, which furnishes water as a public utility, who shall willfully turn on the water after the same shall have been shut off by or under the direction of the Town of Ennis for non-payment of water charges, or who shall unlayfully take water from such water system, or shall willfully open and use water from a fire hydrant without first getting consent from the Mayor or Water Commisioner shall be guilty of a misdemeanor punishable By a fine of not less than fifty dollars (\$50.00) nor more than three hundred (\$300.00) or not more than ninety (90) days in jail or both.
