

ORDINANCE NO. 24

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF A ZONING COMMISSION TO SUBMIT RECOMMENDATIONS FOR ZONING, PRESCRIBING THE DUTIES OF SUCH COMMISSION; LIMITING THE RECOMMENDATIONS TO FUTURE USE; PROVIDING FOR APPOINTMENT AND ORGANIZATION OF SUCH COMMISSION.

Be it ordained by the Town Council of the Town of Ennis:

1. That pursuant to the authority contained in Chapter 27, Title II of the Revised Codes of the State of Montana, 1947, as Amended, there is hereby established a Zoning Commission for the said Town of Ennis which shall in all events act pursuant to the authority of Section 11-2706 RCM 1947.

2. That the said Commission shall, pursuant to authority of Statutes of the State of Montana, recommend to the Town Council the establishment of various zoning districts and appropriate regulations to be enforced therein and shall make preliminary report and after hearings, make final report to the Town Council concerning such recommendations.

3. That following final report of said Zoning Commission the Town Council shall hold public hearings in relation to thereto and in relation to the establishment of Zoning Ordinance.

4. That all regulations recommended by such zoning commission shall pertain to future use of property and not affect existing uses of property.

5. That said Zoning Commission shall consist of three members, who shall select their own chairman and shall be appointed by resolution of the Town Council. Upon the resignation, death or removal of any member of said Zoning Commission the Council may by resolution appoint a new member to maintain the number of said commission at three. Commission members shall be resident freeholders of the Town of Ennis.
