

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING ENTRANCE INTO AN INTERSECTION WITH FACING YIELD SIGNS WITHOUT YIELDING THE RIGHT OF WAY TO ANY MOTOR VEHICLE UPON THE INTERSECTED STREET; DESIGNATING YIELD STREET INTERSECTIONS WITHIN THE TOWN OF ENNIS PROVIDING FOR PUNISHMENT IN CASE OF VIOLATION THEREOF:

BE IT **ORDAINED** BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF ENNIS:

Section 1. That it shall hereafter be unlawful and a violation of this Ordinance for any individual driving a motor vehicle within the Town of Ennis to enter into any intersection upon which a yield sign is erected facing the individual without yielding the right of way to any motor vehicle upon the intersected street except when directed to proceed by a police officer or highway patrolman or traffic control light.

Section 2. That there are hereafter designated as yield streets at which yield signs shall be erected those streets hereinafter named when they intersect the streets named immediately thereafter:

- Armitage Street intersecting First Street
- Armitage Street intersecting Third Street
- Highway U. S. 287 intersecting State Highway 287 leading Westerly

Section 3. Any person violating the provisions of this Ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be punishable by a fine of not less than five dollars nor more than fifty dollars.
