

ORDINANCE NO. 30

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR LIMITED PARKING ON THE NORTH SIDE OF MAIN STREET ADJACENT TO THE EAST HALF OF LOT FOURTEEN AND THE WEST HALF OF LOT FIFTEEN IN BLOCK ONE, ORIGINAL TOWNSITE OF ENNIS; DEFINING PARKING; PROVIDING FOR PUNISHMENT IN CASE OF VIOLATION THEREOF:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF ENNIS:

Section 1. That it shall be unlawful and a violation of this ordinance to park a motor vehicle in excess of ~~ten~~ minutes upon the street in the Town of Ennis adjacent to the East half of Lot 14 and the West half of Lot 15, Block 1 of the Original Townsite of Ennis during the hours from 8:00 o'clock A.M. to 5:00 o'clock P.M. on all days except national holidays and Sundays.

Section 2. For the purposes of this ordinance parking shall consist of standing in a vehicle whether occupied or not for a period of time greater than reasonably necessary for the actual unloading or loading of persons.

Section 3. Any person violating the provisions of this ordinance, shall, upon conviction thereof be punishable by a fine not less than \$ 3.00 nor more than \$ 25.00.

Section 4. The effective date of this ordinance shall be August 1 1966.
