

ORDINANCE NO. 31

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR PERMITS FOR THE DUMPING OF REFUSE, WASTE, GARBAGE AND MOTOR VEHICLE BODIES, UPON THE TOWN DUMP OF THE TOWN OF ENNIS, PROVIDING FOR THE FEE PAYABLE FOR SUCH PERMITS AND BY WHOM ISSUED, PROVIDING FOR HOURS DURING WHICH DUMPING MAY BE CARRIED OUT ON SAID DUMP GROUNDS, PROVIDING FOR CONTENTS OF SUCH PERMITS, PROVIDING FOR CHARGES TO BE MADE TO GOVERNMENTAL AGENCIES FOR USE OF THE TOWN DUMP GROUNDS, PROHIBITING THE DUMPING OF DEAD ANIMAL CARCASSES OR PORTION THEREOF UPON THE SAID TOWN DUMP GROUNDS PROVIDING FOR THE ISSUANCE OF A PERMIT FOR SCAVENGING UPON SAID DUMP GROUNDS AND PROVIDING FOR PUNISHMENT IN CASE OF VIOLATION OF THE PROVISIONS OF THIS ORDINANCE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of Ennis, Montana.

1. That any person whether a resident of the Town of Ennis or not, desiring to dump or cause to be dumped, refuse, waste, or garbage upon the dump grounds owned by the Town of Ennis situate approximately 2 miles North of the Town of Ennis, shall, prior to using the same or causing said act, obtain from the proper officers of the town a permit for the same.

2. Said permit shall be sold by the authorized town officers for the sum of \$3.00, payable to the Town Treasurer, provided, however, that an additional sum of \$1.00 shall be charged for each additional unit serviced by the permittee other than his own.

3. Said permits shall be issued by the Town Clerk, ~~the Mayor~~, the Town Marshal or a Sanitary Engineer appointed by the Mayor with the approval of the council.

4. Said permits shall run for the fiscal year i.e. from July 1 of any one year through the 30th day of June of the following year, provided, however, that such permit shall, during the year 1966 be effective commencing July 6, 1966.

5. Said permits shall further provide for hours during which dumping shall be permitted which shall be clearly indicated on the permits and further said hours for dumping shall

be from 7:00 A.M. to 8:00 P.M. on each and every day.

6. Said permits shall further set forth that a ten dollar minimum fine shall be assessed in case of dumping in violation of this ordinance.

7. In lieu of said permits in the case of governmental agencies, including but not limited to the Montana Fish and Game Department, the United States Forest Service, The Department of the Interior or any other subdivision of the United States Government or of the Government of the State of Montana and its political subdivisions a charge shall be made to said unit of \$10.00 per year, payable to the Town Treasurer for each and every facility serviced by such agency from which refuse, waste or garbage is removed and deposited upon the dump grounds owned by the Town of Ennis.

8. No motor vehicle bodies shall be dumped or caused to be dumped upon said dump ground by any person without first obtaining from one of those officers authorized to issue permits herein a special permit therefor in the sum of \$7.50 per motor vehicle body dumped payable to the Town Treasurer.

9. No person shall dump or cause to be dumped the carcass of a dead animal or any part or portion thereof upon the said town dump grounds.

10. No person shall scavenge upon the dump grounds without a permit therefor which shall be obtained from those officers authorized to issue permits herein which said permit shall be issued for a fee of \$25.00 per fiscal year payable to the Town Treasurer.

11. Any person dumping or causing to be dumped refuse, waste, garbage or motor vehicle bodies or scavenging upon the town dump grounds without a duly issued permit therefor

or dumping or causing to be dumped such matters upon the Town dump grounds contrary to the provisions of this ordinance shall upon conviction thereof be punishable by a fine of not less than ten dollars nor more than 25 dollars or by imprisonment for not to exceed 30 days or both such fine and imprisonment and provided further that in the case of the dumping of dead animal carcasses upon said dump grounds the fine shall be not less than twenty-five dollars.
