ORDINANCE NO. 32

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING THAT EFFECTIVE SIX MONTHS AFTER COMPLETION OF THE TOWN SEWER SYSTEM NO SEWAGE OR HUMAN WASTES SHALL BE DEPOSITED IN SEWAGE DISPOSAL SYSTEMS OTHER THAN MUNICIPAL SEWAGE SYSTEM: PROHIBITING AND DECLARING A NUISANCE THE MAINTENANCE AND USE OF outhouses AND OUTDOOR TOILETS: PROVIDING FOR PUNISHMENT FOR VIOLATION THEREOF AND FOR AN INJUNCTION AGAINST THE PROSCRIBED CONDUCT AND PROVIDING FOR EFFECTIVE DATE THEREOF:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF ENNIS

1, That from and after six months following the completion of the sewer collection and outfall and treatment facilities system of the Town of Ennis it shall be unlawful and a nuisance and a violation of this ordinance within the Town of Ennis to discharge sewage or human wastes into any septic tank, cess pool or other sewage system other than the sewerage collection lines, outfall lines and treatment facilities of the Town of Ennis.

2. That from and after six months following completion of a sewer collection, outfall and treatment facilities system of the Town of Ennis it shall be unlawful and a violation of this ordinance and will thereafter be declared a nuisance to maintain and use within the town limits of the town any outhouse, outdoor toilet or outdoor facility for the disposal of human wastes.

3. That the date of completion of said sewer collection outfall and lagoon treatment system shall be determined by Resolution of the Town Council after the construction thereof is accepted by the said council.

4. Any person violating a provision of this ordinance shall upon conviction thereof be punished by a fine of not to exceed 100 dollars and imprisonment not to exceed 30 days; provided however that the Town and its officers may in addition to enforcement of this ordinance by prosecution under this provision obtain an injunction against the individual or firm violating the provisions hereof as an injunction against a nuisance.
