

ORDINANCE NO. 33

AN ORDINANCE PRESCRIBING RATES FOR USE OF THE MUNICIPAL SEWER SYSTEM BEING CONSTRUCTED BY THE TOWN OF ENNIS AND PROVIDING FOR EFFECTIVE DATE THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF ENNIS

That the following rates are established, subject to the approval of the State Railroad and Public Service Commission, for use upon such sewer facilities as may be constructed by the Town of Ennis effective upon the commencement of operation of its Sewer Collection System, Outfall Lines and Lagoon Treatment Facilities.

1. That the basic rate applicable to all sewer installations in a location where water is used from the municipal water system shall be based upon the quantities of water used and at the following prices;

First	3,000 gallons per month	\$2.50	minimum
Next	2,000 gallons per month	.35	per 1,000 gallons
Next	3,000 gallons per month	.325	per 1,000 gallons
Next	10,000 gallons per month	.25	per 1,000 gallons
Next	10,000 gallons per month	.175	per 1,000 gallons
Next	10,000 gallons per month	.15	per 1,000 gallons
Over	41,000 gallons per month	.10	per 1,000 gallons

2. That the rate applicable to all sewer installations where water is not used from the municipal water system the charge shall be \$2.50 per toilet bowl per month on the first two toilet bowls and 50¢ per bowl over two in such installation situate at the installation.

3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon completion of construction of the sewer collection, outfall and treatment facilities and in no case less than thirty days from the enactment hereof.
