ORDINANCE NO. 34

AN ORDINANCE PRESCRIBING RATES FOR USE OF THE MUNICIPAL SEWER SYSTEM OF THE TOWN OF ENNIS AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH AND PROVIDING FOR EFFECTIVE DATE THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF ENNIS That the following rates are established, subject to the approval of the State Railroad and Public Service Commission, for use upon such sewer facilities as may be constructed by the Town of Ennis effective upon the commencement of operation of its Sewer Collection System, Outfall Lines and Lagoon Treatment Facilities.

1. That the basic rate applicable to all sewer installations at a general commercial point of use shall be \$5.00 per month. A general commercial use shall be defined as (a) where the use of the facilities is such that the general public patronizes the general facilities of the establishment in such a manner that a burden is placed upon the sewer facilities of the establishment and (b) where the said establishment uses municipal water at a rate of more than 3,000 gallons per month or uses water exclusively from a private water system.

2. That the basic rate applicable to all sewer installations at a limited commercial point of use shall be \$3.00 per month. A limited commercial use shall be defined as a commercial or business establishment as defined in paragraph 1(a) above and where said establishment uses municipal water at a rate of not more than 3,000 gallons per month.

3. That the basic rate applicable to all sewer installations at a residential point of use shall be \$3.00 per month. A residential use shall be one single-family dwelling. In case of multiple-family dwellings the basic residential charge shall be made for each family residing on the premises. An apartment building or other multiple-family facility on the municipal water system with an authorized single water meter for the establishment shall not be considered a multiple-family dwelling and shall be charged under a general or limited commercial rate.

4. That the monthly rate shall apply to any use made between the 20th day of one month and the 20th day of the following month. No partial month use shall be assessed or credited.

5. That in the case of initial connection to the sewer lines charges will commence on the 20th day of the month after a period of 30 days has passed since final inspection is made and installation approved by the Sewer Inspector.

6. Monthly service charges will be suspended during periods of complete non-use of the premises involved, provided that the user, occupant or owner notifies the Town Clerk of such suspension of use and suspension will be effective on the day such notice is given or on the day non-use commences whichever is later. Charges will be reinstated on the day use recommences.

7. This ordinance will be effective upon passage and approval there now existing an emergency in regard to use of ~~said sewer~~ sewer.

8. All previous ordinances in regard to sewer rates in

conflict herewith including but not limited to Ordinance No.33
passed November 7, 1966 are hereby repealed.
