

ORDINANCE NO. 38

AN ORDINANCE DEFINING SOLICITING, PEDDLING AND HAWKING AND DISPOSING AT A PRIVATE RESIDENCE WITHOUT INVITATION AS A NUISANCE AND PROVIDING FOR PUNISHMENT FOR VIOLATION THEREOF

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF ENNIS, MONTANA AS FOLLOWS:

That the practice of going in and upon private residences in the Town of Ennis by solicitors, peddlers, hawkers, itinerant merchants and vendors of merchandise, not having been requested or invited to do so by the owner or owners, occupant or occupants of said private residences for the purpose of soliciting orders for the sale of goods, wares, services and merchandise and/or for the purpose of disposing of and/or peddling or hawking the same is declared to be a nuisance.

Any person, firm or corporation convicted of violating any of the provisions of this ordinance or doing any of the things hereinbefore described as a nuisance shall be punishable by a fine not exceeding \$300.00 or imprisonment not exceeding 30 days or both such fine and imprisonment.
