

ORDINANCE NO 4

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING THAT IT SHALL BE UNLAWFUL TO PERMIT CERTAIN LIVESTOCK TO RUN AT LARGE WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE TOWN OF ENNIS , PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF ENNIS:

Section 1 . That it shall be unlawful to suffer or permit any horse ,mule, <sup>stallion</sup>~~mare~~, gelding, mare , colt or donkey , or any cow , steer ,bull, heifer or calf , or any swine or sheep or goat to run at large at any time within the corporate limits of the Town of Ennis , and any person having in his possession or under his control, any such animal, who shall suffer or permit the same to run at large in said Town of Ennis shall be deemed guilty of a violation of this ordinance ;

Section 2. The act of permitting each such animal to run at large shall be deemed a separate offense and each day or portion of a day ~~that~~ said act of permission or suffering such animal to ~~to~~ run at large as aforesaid shall be deemed to constitute a separate offense

Section 3: Upon conviction of the offense mentioned in the foregoing sections, such person shall be punished by a fine of not less th an Five Dolâars nor more than twenty-five dolâars.

Section 4: This act shall not apply to the animals named when passing through town under the direct control of a herder or herders provided that such herders be sufficient to control the said animals.
