

ORDINANCE NO. 51

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR CONTAINERIZATION OF GARBAGE OR REFUSE, DEFINING GARBAGE AND REFUSE, PROHIBITING GARBAGE TO BE COLLECTED FOR DEPOSIT AT DUMP AND FROM BEING DEPOSITED AT DUMP UNLESS CONTAINERIZED AND PROVIDING PENALTY FOR VIOLATION.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF ENNIS.

1. That it appearing that a public health and pollution problem exists as to loose refuse and garbage deposited at the Town Dump due to high wind condition it is necessary that such refuse and garbage be sacked or containerized.

2. From and after the effective date of this Ordinance, to-wit 30 days from the adoption hereof no garbage or refuse shall be deposited at the Town Dump unless the same be in a container or sack being capable of being fully closed.

3. garbage shall include waste food products, trimmings and leavings.

4. Refuse shall include paper products of all types, including plastic wrappings, synthetic papers and wood product papers.

5. No garbage or refuse shall be picked up by the contractor on said dump for deposit in the said dump unless containerized as above set forth.

6. Any person depositing garbage or refuse not containerized as above set forth in the Town Dump shall upon conviction of violation of this ordinance be punishable by a fine of not more than \$50.00
