AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR SOLID WASTE DISPOSAL AND REMOVAL: PROVIDING TAX FOR DEFRAYING COST OF CONTRACT TO PERFORM THE SAME: PROVIDING FOR MANNER OF COLLECTING SAME and PROVIDING FOR IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVENESS BY REASON OF EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF ENNIS:

1. That the Town shall under the provisions of Section 11-909, RCM 1947 as amended provide by contract for the disposition and removal of ashes, garbage, refuse and other offensive matter from the streets, alleys and other premises within the Town by entering into a contract for removal and disposition thereof with a private contractor.

2. That the cost of such disposition and removal shall be defrayed by a tax to be levied against the property from which such material and matter was deposited which said tax shall be based upon the following considerations:

A. A tax of \$3.50 per month shall be assessed to each household with two or more persons.

B. A tax of \$2.00 per month shall be assessed to each household with one person.

3. The foregoing charges shall be for pick up of three (3) cans of not to exceed thirty-five gallon capacity. Contractor shall have the right to bill householders directly for any service in excess of the above.

4. The foregoing tax shall be collected by being charged to the owners thereof upon monthly statement of sewer charges sent to each property owner or occupant.

5. There being at this time no existing official solid waste disposal system within the Town and the same threatening to become a grave immediate nuisance to the Town the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed to be effective immediately by reason of emergency.

Passed by the council and approved by the Mayor this 4th day of September 1973.
