

1 of the curb, or where there is no curb, from the established curb-
2 line, and the lowest portion of an overhanging device should be at
3 least seven and one-half (7½) feet above the top of the curb, side-
4 walk or roadway shoulder elevation.

5 SECTION 6. PURPOSE - It is the purpose and intent of this Code to
6 provide minimum standards to safeguard life, health, property and
7 public welfare by regulating and controlling the placement of all
8 signs and sign structures within the incorporated limits so as to
9 prevent the obstruction of view of any official traffic sign, signal
10 or device.

11 SECTION 7. ENFORCEMENT - Authorized City and County officials are
12 hereby directed to enforce all of the provisions of this Code as
13 provided herein and in accordance with the provisions of Sections
14 32-4405 to 32-4409, inclusive, R.C.M., 1947. Any person, firm or
15 corporation violating the provisions of this Ordinance shall be,
16 in addition to the penalties provided by the aforementioned Montana
17 Law, punishable by a fine not to exceed Three Hundred Dollars
18 (\$300.00).
