

ORDINANCE NO. 76

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 9.10 OF THE TOWN CODE OF ENNIS:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF ENNIS, MONTANA:

FIREWORKS

9.10.010 REGULATIONS: It shall be a violation of this chapter to ignite, explode or fire off any rockets, firecrackers, Roman Candles, torpedoes or any substance of an explosive nature within the corporate limits of the Town on any day of the year ~~other than the Third, Fourth and Fifth days of July in each and every year provided~~, however, upon application to the Town commission, duly approved by the commission and the mayor, bona fide persons and organizations may obtain a permit for the use of fireworks in connection with celebration or other occasions of public interest.

9.01.20 NOTIFICATIONS TO PURCHASERS: Any persons, business establishments or organizations selling firecrackers, Roman Candles, rockets, torpedoes or any other substance of an explosive nature, must post a notice in a conspicuous place stating that it is illegal to ignite, explode or fire off any rockets, firecrackers, Roman Candles, torpedoes or any other substance of an explosive nature within the corporate limits of the Town.

9.01.030 VIOLATIONS: PENALTY. Violations of this section shall be punishable by a fine of not less than ~~five dollars (\$5.00)~~ twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) nor more than ~~fifty dollars (\$50.00)~~ one-hundred dollars (\$100.00)

All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
