

ORDINANCE NO. 77

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF ENNIS TO AMEND CHAPTER 15.02 OF THE ENNIS TOWN CODES PERMITTING UNLICENSED PLUMBERS TO PRACTICE IN THE FIELD OF PLUMBING, AS DEFINED BY 37-69-101 (4) MCA, WHEN A DULY LICENSED PLUMBER IS UNAVAILABLE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF ENNIS:

15.02.010 UNLICENSED PLUMBERS PERMITTED TO DO PLUMBING

Any person constructing a residence, home, commercial building or other structure within the Town is authorized to employ such person as he may see fit in and about the field of plumbing upon such residence, home, commercial building or structure, whether or not such persons have obtained a license from the State of Montana, providing, that a duly licensed plumber is not reasonably available to perform such duties.

15.02.020 LICENSED PLUMBER AVAILABLE

If a duly licensed plumber by the State of Montana, is reasonably available an unlicensed plumber shall not be permitted to practice in the field of plumbing, until he has been duly licensed by the State of Montana, within the incorporated limits of the Town of Ennis.

All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Passed by the Ennis Town Council and approved by the Mayor on this 28th day of April, 1983.

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect thirty days after its adoption by the Ennis Town Council and duly notice has been given to the public.
