

ORDINANCE NO. 94

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR THE DESIGNATION OF ONE WAY STREETS, AND PENALTY FOR VIOLATION OF SAID REGULATIONS.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of Ennis:

Chapter 10.18

ONE WAY STREETS

Sections:

- 10.18.010 Designation
- 10.18.020 Prohibitions
- 10.18.030 Penalty Clause
- 10.18.040 One Way Streets
- 10.18.050 Markings

10.18.010 Designation. The Town Council may designate any street as a one way street if it finds such a designation is necessary for the public safety.

10.18.020 Prohibitions. It is unlawful for any person to operate a motor vehicle on a one way street other than in the designated direction of traffic flow.

10.18.030 Penalty Clause. A violation of this ordinance is punishable by a fine of not less than \$10.00 nor more than \$300.00.

10.18.040 One Way Streets. The following are designated as one way streets:

A. Charles Street, with traffic flow from West Main Street (also denoted as Montana Highway 287) to Hugle Street.

10.18.050 Markings. All one way streets shall be plainly marked by appropriate signs.
